

Pine Valley 2050 began in June 2022 when a group of community members realized the importance of developing a plan for the valley's future.

Within just a few months, Pine Valley 2050 became a project of United Community Partners, established a steering committee, hired a community builder, built a website and created a mission of "working together for a vibrant Pine Valley Community."

As part of that mission the Pine Valley 2050 steering committee developed a community survey with support from Launchpad Baker and Rural Development Initiatives (RDI).

The survey was widely distributed in December 2022, and 268 residents responded. Pine Eagle high school students developed and distributed their own survey, and 36 students responded.

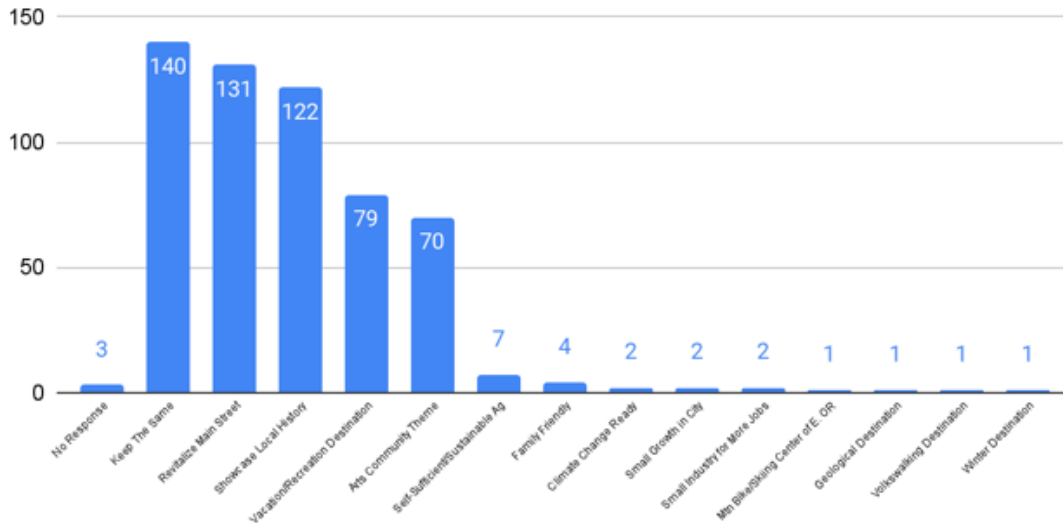
133 went online to fill out the survey;

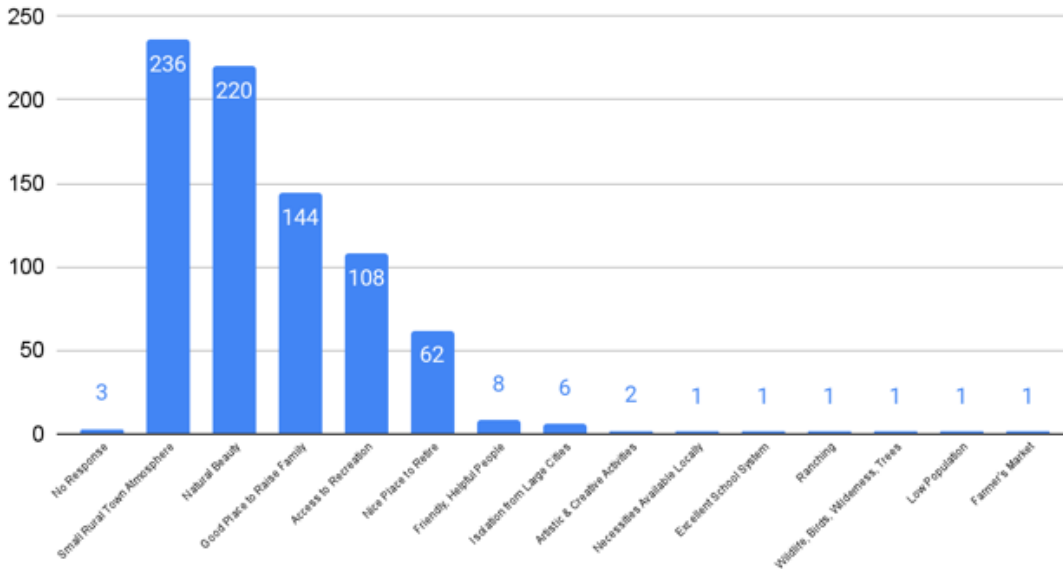

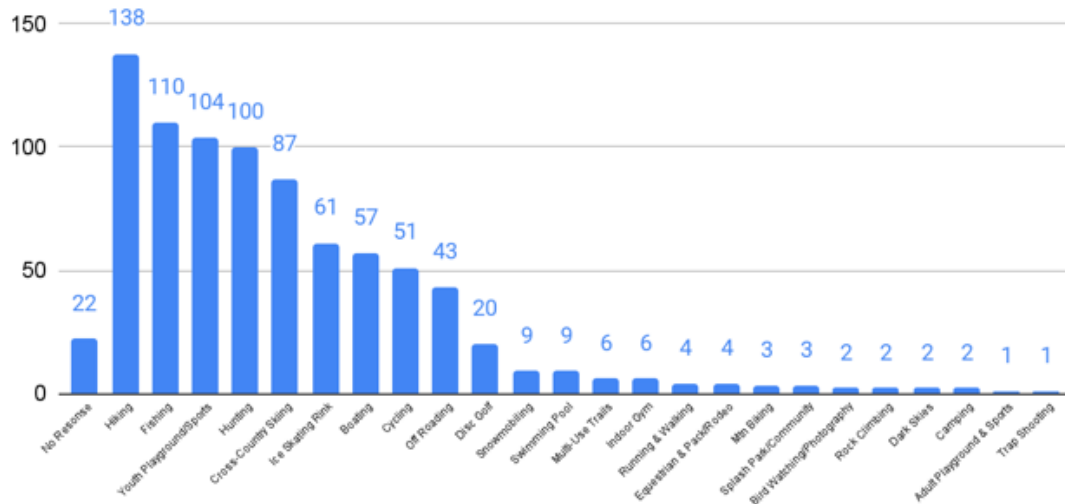
1. What Respondents Want Pine Valley to Look Like and be Known For by the Year 2050



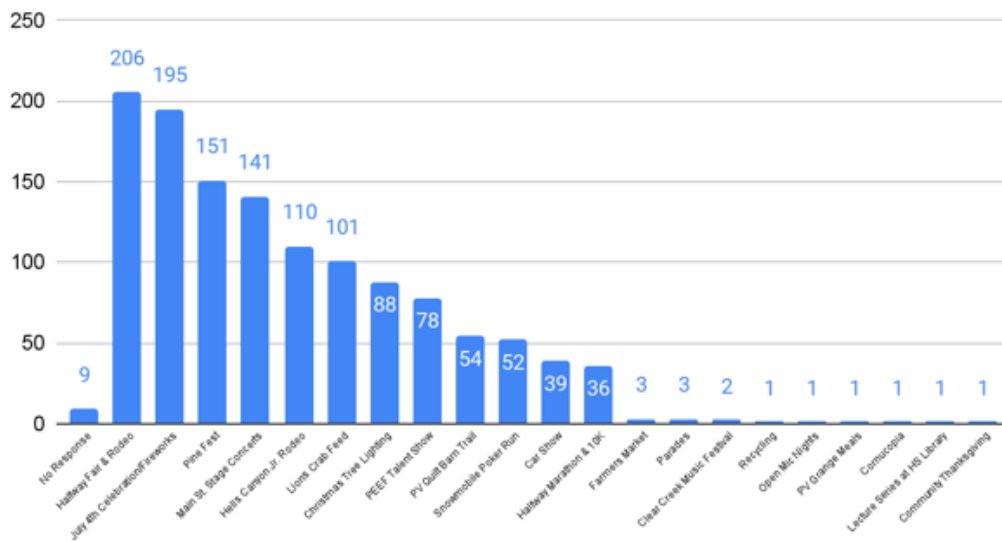
2. Things Most Liked About Pine Valley



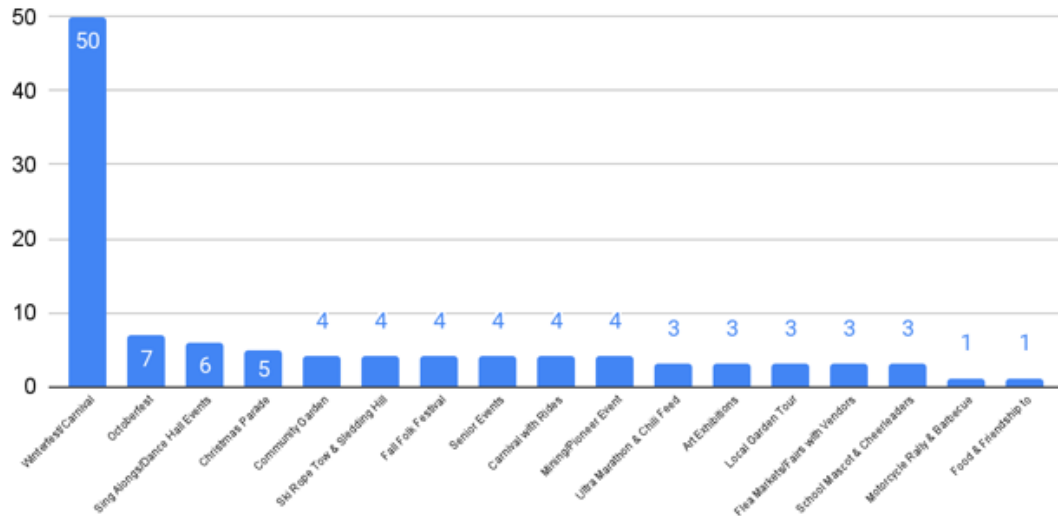
3. Most Important Recreational Activity if Money Became Available



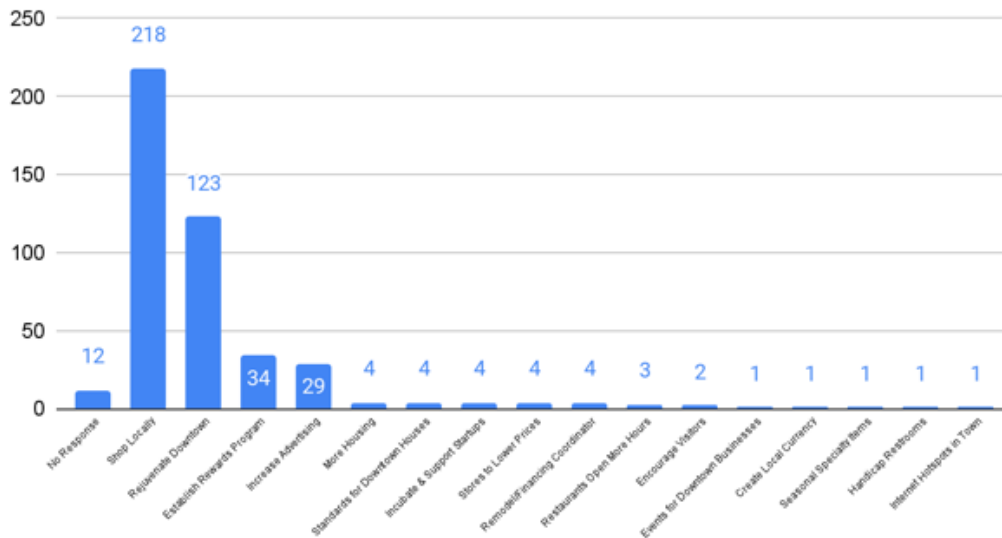
4. Local Events Attended in the Last Five Years



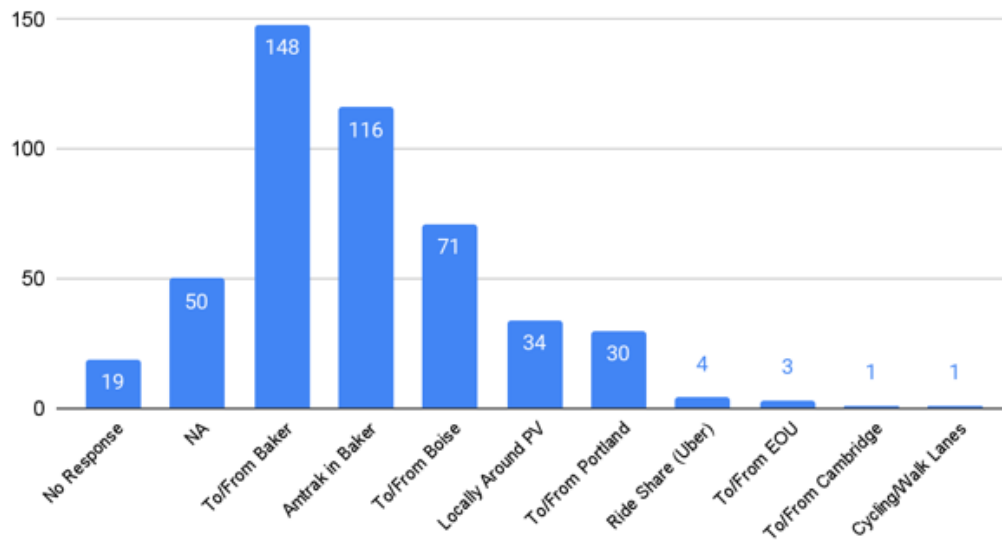
5. Community Events Respondents Would Like to See Come Back



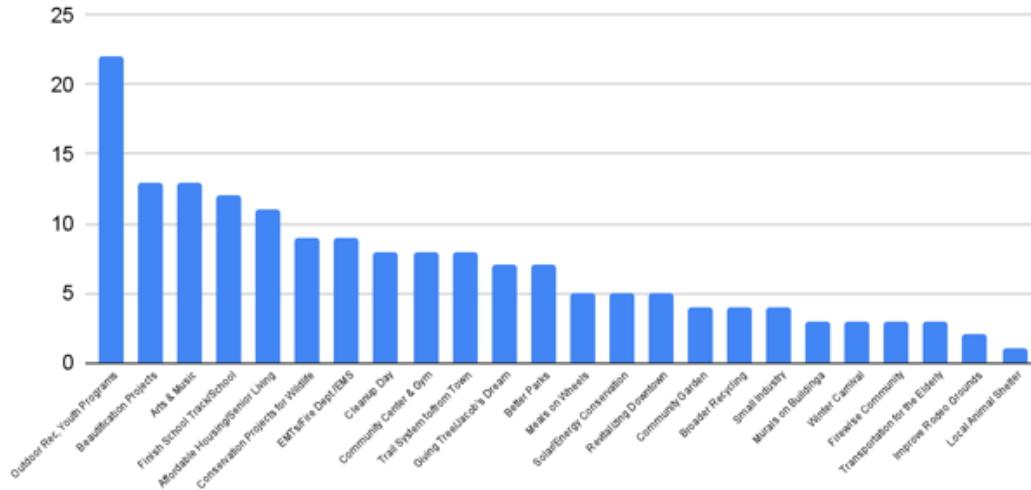
6. How We Can Best Support Local Businesses in Pine Valley



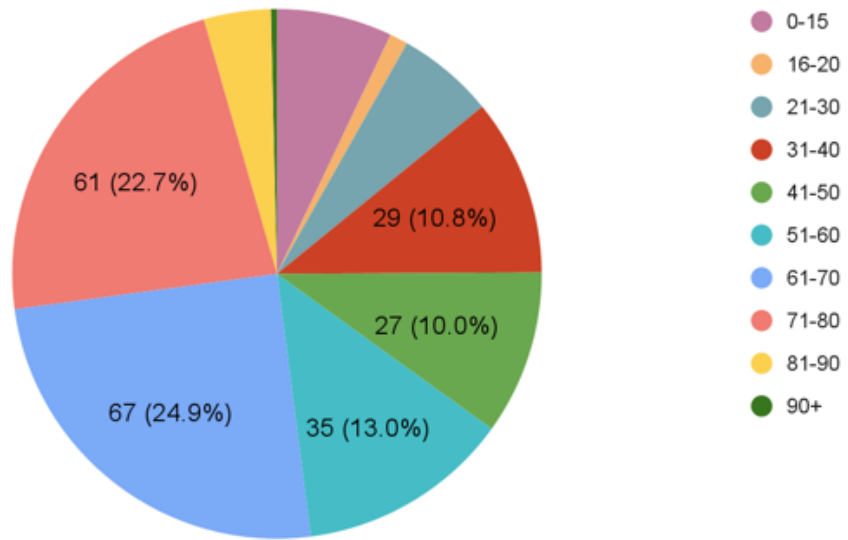
7. Public Transportation Options Most Important to Respondents



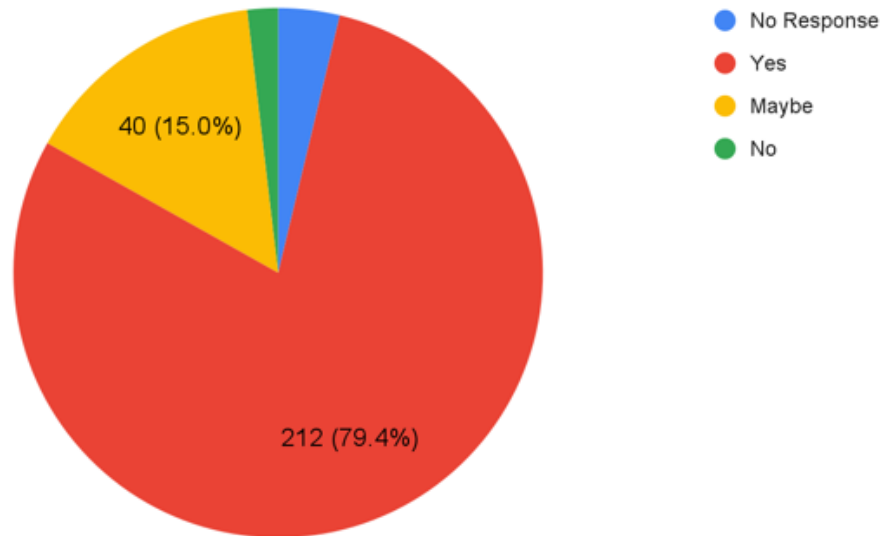
8. Projects or Services Respondents Would Support Financially or Through Volunteering



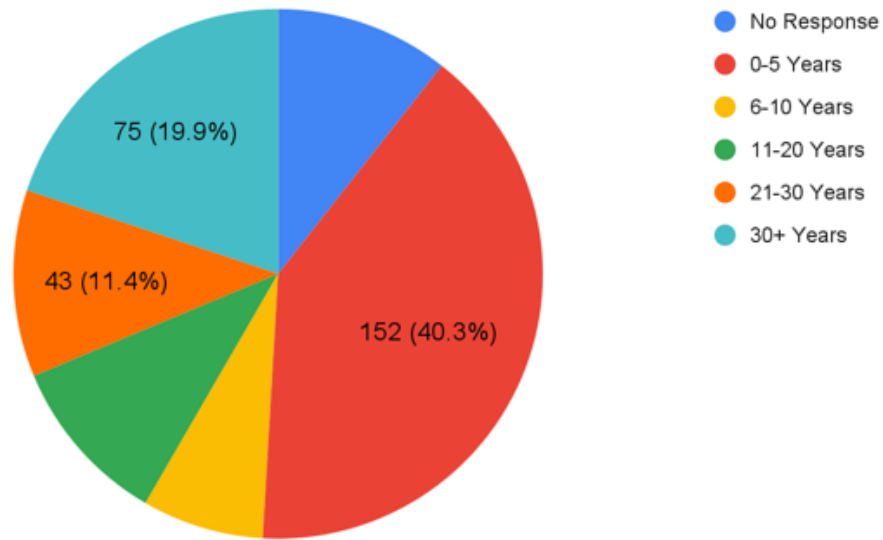
9. Age of Respondents



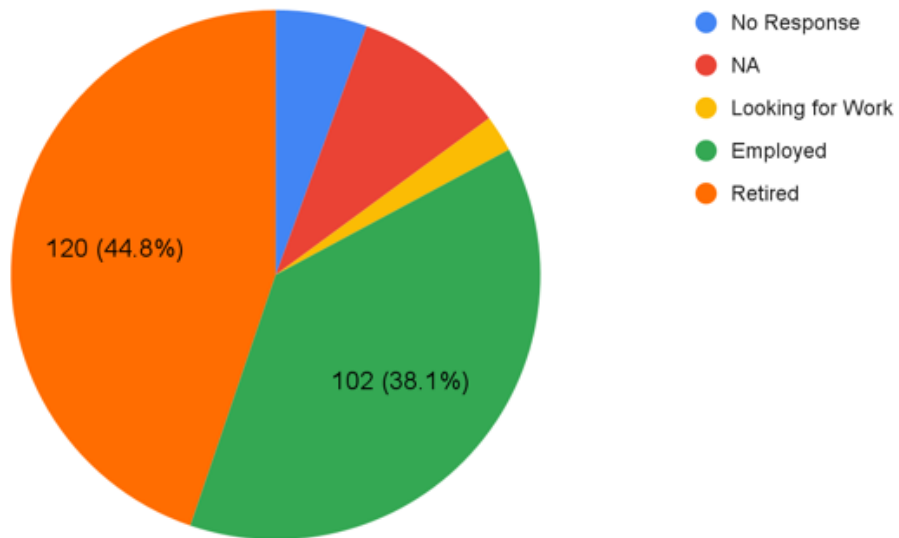
10. Respondents Planning to Remain in Pine Valley
