Daycare:

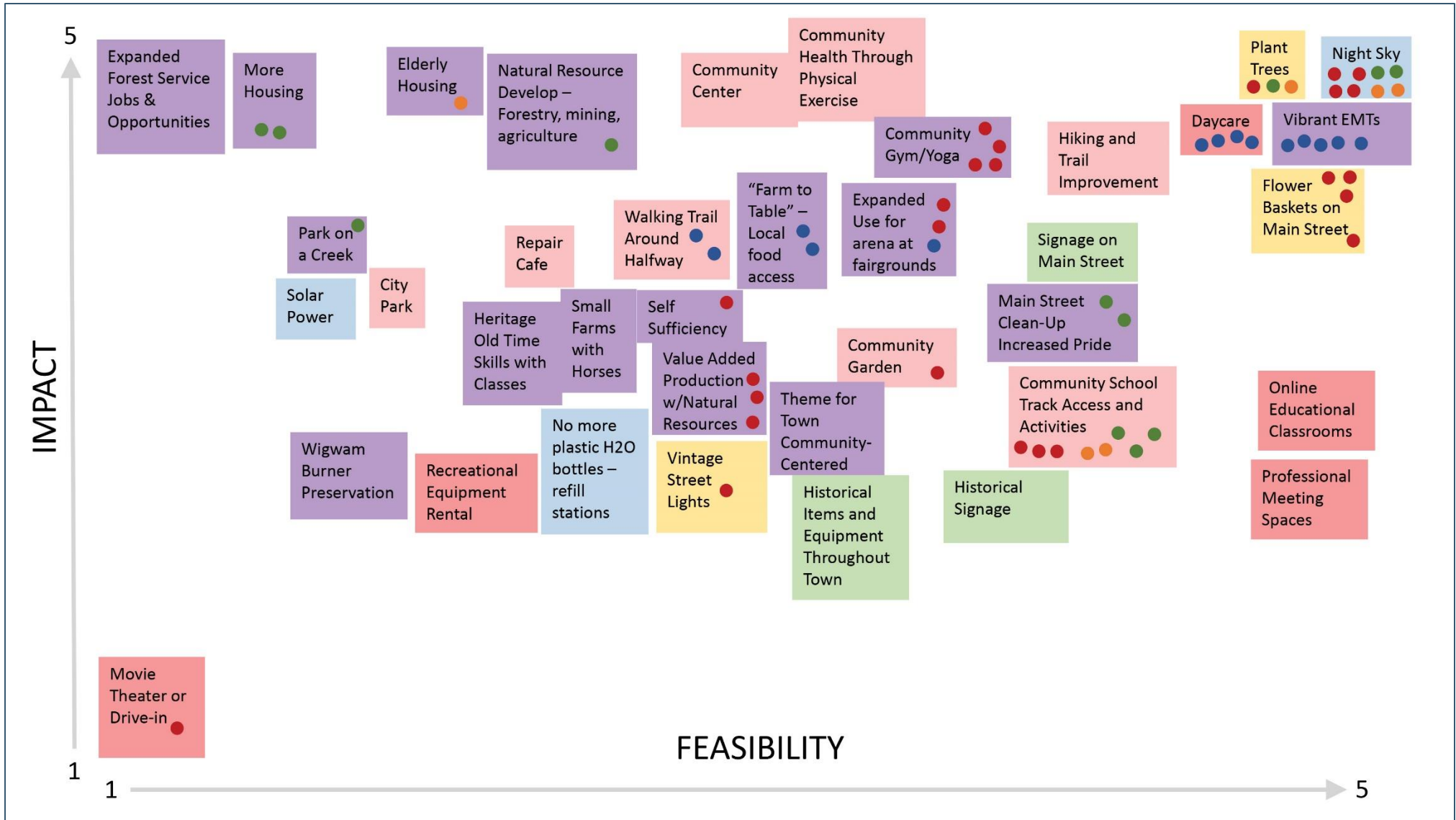
Certified facility for young families to take their children younger than school age in combination with a senior center
